**RESOLUTION N° 2**

**NEW FEE SCALE FOR THE MEMBER STATES FROM 2020**

The 48<sup>th</sup> Meeting of the Directing Council of the Pan-American Institute for Geography and History (PAIGH),

**CONSIDERING:**

Resolutions No. 10 and 11, approved at the 21st PAIGH General Assembly (Panama, 2017);

Resolution CP/RES.1103(2168/18) approved by the Permanent Council of the OAS;

Article 16 of the PAIGH Organic Statutes, which states:

“The Directing Council is the permanent Pan American body of the PAIGH entrusted with functions of the General Assembly during the intervals between the meetings of the latter”;

Article 39 of the Organic Statutes of the PAIGH, which establishes that:

“The quotas shall be computed according to the scale of contributions used by the General Secretariat of the Organization of American States”;

The proposals for new fee scales submitted by the General Secretariat to the Member States;

That recommended by the 89<sup>th</sup> and the 90<sup>th</sup> Meetings of the Authorities, and by the Financial Policy Committee,
